### Highly Experienced in Complex Antitrust Cases

**Highly experienced** in complex antitrust cases, including:

- Won dismissal of class action complaint alleging allocation of markets in private label retailing. *Bedi v. Hewlett-Packard Co. and Staples*
- Antitrust counsel for principal defendants in more than \$3 billion antitrust claim asserted by United Airlines and its Creditors Committee; claims recently dismissed by Seventh Circuit Court of Appeals.
