The article discusses the recent enforcement actions by Federal Trade Commission (FTC) against regulated healthcare companies – particularly in the areas of mental health, substance use disorder treatment, and reproductive health – using digital tracking technologies to gather user’s sensitive information in website or app interactions and share that information with third parties.

The authors’ note: “For those who may have thought these enforcement actions would be few and far between, a July 20 joint letter from the FTC and HHS OCR issued to more than 130 hospitals and health care providers makes clear that this area will continue to be at the forefront for the foreseeable future.”
