Christine Savage Earns Distinguished Achievement Award from UMass Amherst

Christine Savage will receive a Distinguished Achievement Award at the University of Massachusetts Amherst (UMass Amherst) Undergraduate Commencement ceremony on Friday, May 16, 2025.

Christine earned a BA, cum laude, from UMass Amherst in 1992 where she was a Harry S. Truman Scholar. She serves as a director and the secretary/clerk for the UMass Amherst Foundation's Board of Trustees and is a former chair of the College of Social and Behavioral Sciences Dean's Advisory Board. She is also a founding member of the UMass Club. Christine established the Dr. Charles W. Solt and Doris J. Solt Scholarship at UMass Amherst in honor of her parents and to support out-of-state undergraduates pursuing studies in the social and behavioral sciences.
